About Chesapeake

History

Chesapeake, Virginia was established in 1963 after the merger of Norfolk County and the City of South Norfolk. Chesapeake also played a significant role in the founding of America, with the historic Battle of Great Bridge, and the construction of the Great Dismal Swamp Canal. Today, Chesapeake honors its position in history with a vibrant present and promising future.



Location & Growth

Adjacent to the world's largest naval base, Chesapeake is conveniently located 20 minutes from the Atlantic Ocean, 15 minutes from downtown Norfolk, and one hour from Colonial Williamsburg and the Outer Banks of North Carolina. With an estimated population of 253,000, Chesapeake is the second largest city in Virginia and one of the 100 largest cities in the United States. As one of Virginia's fastest growing cities, Chesapeake has significant potential for future residential, commercial, and industrial growth.

Economic Opportunity

Chesapeake has all the features businesses seek including talent, infrastructure, and desirable location. The Organization

The City operates under the Council-Manager form of government with the City Manager having oversight for daily operations. The City government employs approximately 3,500 people in more than 35 departments with an annual operating budget of more than \$2.2 billion.



The Department

The Chesapeake Public Library is comprised of 121 full-time equivalent positions (FTEs), 7 full-service neighborhood libraries, a Law Library, 2 outreach vans, 5 outreach vehicles, and 3 book vending machines.

Position Overview

Under the administrative direction of the City Manager, the Director of Chesapeake Library System provides strategic planning, long- and short-term goal setting, oversight and compliance with operating outcome-based budgets, and appropriate utilization of departmental and City resources. This position is responsible for oversight of all library operations, maintenance of library facilities, and promotion of library programs and services within the community at large.



Priorities & Responsibilities

- Provides leadership, vision, and strategic direction for the Chesapeake Public Library ensuring alignment with City Council goals and the evolving needs of the community.
- Oversees all library operations, including strategic planning, budget development and management, personnel supervision, policy implementation, and facility maintenance.
- Builds and maintains strong relationships with City departments, community partners, elected officials, and state and national library organizations to promote collaboration and innovation.
- Ensures effective communication and professional decision-making across the organization, supporting staff development and maintaining a culture of accountability and high-quality customer service.
- Promotes public engagement and library visibility through outreach, advocacy, and partnerships with advisory groups such as the Library Board, Library Foundation, and Friends of the Library.
- Monitors and ensures compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations, as well as internal policies and service standards.
- Uphold the City's organizational values, known as the CARES standards, which staff embody as they carry out the work of the City: Courteousness Making customers feel welcome, appreciated, and respected; Attentiveness Enhancing our ability to identify the needs and concerns of customers; Resourcefulness Demonstrating exceptional creativity, adaptability, and problem-solving skills in support of the City's goals and objectives; Empowerment Possessing the knowledge, resourcefulness, creativity, and integrity to address customers' needs; and Stewardship Demonstrating a commitment to public service; the safety of ourselves, our coworkers, and our community; and being good stewards of our financial & environmental resources.
